Kid’s Castle Playground at Purcell Park Reopens to the Public

Harrisonburg, Va. – Staff with Harrisonburg Parks and Recreation have finished the work to one popular city playground, which has now reopened to the public.

Maintenance staff with the Parks and Recreation Department completed the resurfacing project and made repairs to Kid’s Castle at Purcell Park.

The playground had been closed to the public since June for the expected resurfacing project, when it was also damaged from a series of storms.

Park maintenance staff have replaced the playground surface with engineered wood fiber, repaired playground features where needed, and installed a new border to the playground. Continued upgrades to playground features will take place including the installation of swings that are currently being redesigned.
