Hartman currently serves as the interim director of public works for Harrisonburg. Prior to his interim role, he served as the assistant director of public works and has worked for the city for nearly 5 years. He started working for the city in 2012, where he served as an engineer for public works. He received his undergraduate degree from Old Dominion University in Civil Engineering and holds a professional engineering license.

“I have the utmost confidence that Tom will continue the high level of customer service our residents have come to expect from our Public Works Department. Under Tom’s leadership Public Works will continue to maintain and improve upon our high standards for the City’s transportation infrastructure. I am excited to have Tom as a permanent member of the executive staff,” explained Eric D. Campbell, City Manager.

The Harrisonburg Public Works Department is currently made up of 86 employees and a budget of approximately \$10 million, not including capital projects.
