Assistant Fire Marshal Link Graduates from Law Enforcement School

Harrisonburg, VA—On Friday, November 16th, Assistant Fire Marshal Keith Link with the Harrisonburg Fire Department graduated from the 39th Basic Law Enforcement School for Fire Marshals at Fort Pickett in Blackstone, VA. The Law Enforcement School for Fire Marshals is a 10-week, 400-hour course, that includes classroom and field exercises, allowing graduates to conduct inspections and enforce fire code.

“We are excited to have Keith as an Assistant Fire Marshal in the Harrisonburg Fire Department. We know that he will be an asset to the prevention division and Harrisonburg community as a whole,” said Fire Chief Ian Bennett.

“I am very excited to hold the position of Assistant Fire Marshal for the City of Harrisonburg,” said Link. He added, “The training and experiences I’ve received while in this position have been great and I look forward to seeing what the future of my career holds with the city.”

There were 33 students representing 22 fire departments in this graduating class. Training included basic and tactical firearms training, criminal and constitutional law and forensic investigation.

Link has been employed as a firefighter and medic with the department for three and a half years. Link will assume his duties following graduation with the prevention division of the Harrisonburg Fire Department.
