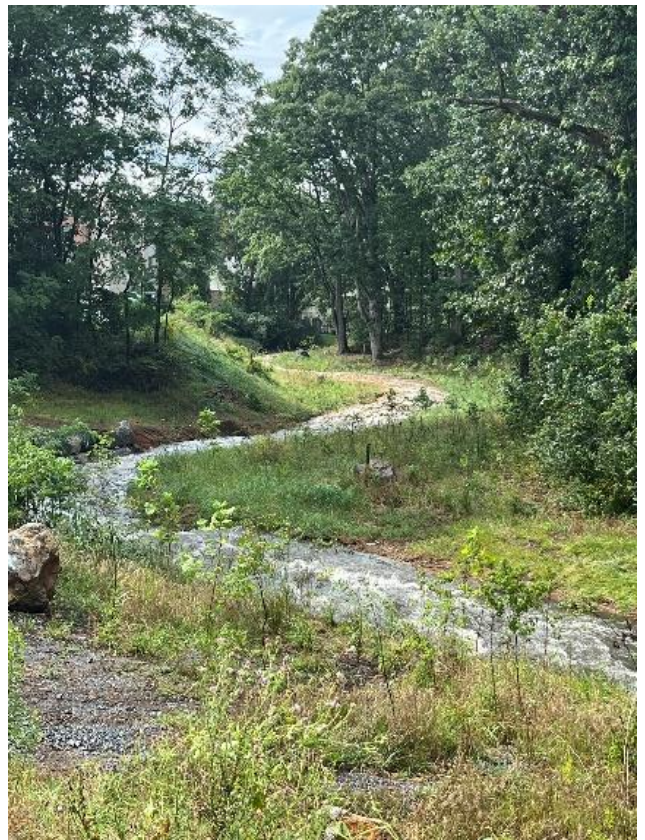
## City to accept comments on Smith Creek TMDL Action Plan

HARRISONBURG, Va. – The City of Harrisonburg’s Public Works Department is accepting comments on an effort to protect the Chesapeake Bay here at home.

The City is updating its Smith Creek Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Action Plan. A TMDL quantifies the maximum amount of pollutants a waterway can carry and the amount of each pollutant that must be reduced to stay within this limit. The Smith Creek TMDL covers two pollutants: bacteria and total suspended solids.

The Action Plan was first created in 2004 and was most recently updated in 2022. The 2024 revision reflects a new permit cycle. The Action Plan identifies the required pollutant reductions and strategies the City will use to reduce bacteria and sediment in the watershed.

Harrisonburg is already active in reducing pollutants in a number of ways. The City has two street sweepers that sweep City streets to reduce sediment and other items from making it into waterways. The City also cleans out storm drains to remove accumulated sediment before it reaches the streams.



The public comment period provides an opportunity for citizens to provide input on the BMPs proposed in the Action Plan as well as a chance to express any concerns about the plan. Members of the community are encouraged to review the plan online at <https://tinyurl.com/SCTMDLActionPlan> and ask City staff questions for additional information. A summary of comments received will be included in the plan as well as any revisions made to the Action Plan as a result of public participation.
