

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Harrisonburg City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, November 10, 2015 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon as the agenda permits, in the City Council Chamber located at 409 South Main Street, to consider the following:

Zoning Ordinance Amendment – Section 10-3-26 (To Allow Required Parking for Business and Professional Office Uses to be Off-Site within Specified Downtown Locations)

Public hearing to consider a request to amend the Zoning Ordinance's Article G Off-Street Parking regulations Section 10-3-26 Location in Relation to Building or Use Served. The amendment would modify subsection (a) (1) by adding the ability for business and professional office uses to meet minimum off-street parking requirements by locating parking spaces on parcels that are not on the same or adjoining parcels from the use served. Such permission will only be allowed for business and professional office uses located within the area bounded by Gay Street to the north, Mason Street to the east, Martin Luther King Jr. Way to the south, and High Street to the west. Parking spaces shall be on parcels zoned where parking is permitted, they may be located across public or private streets and/or alleys, and they shall be no more than one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) mile from the use served. A common or cooperative location shall be in the ownership of all of the participating property owners or shall have easement and maintenance agreements between the participating property owners for a period of at least ten (10) years following the date of city approval.

All persons interested will have an opportunity to express their views at this public hearing.
