This form is to assure compliance with the requirements of the Code of Virginia and the most recently adopted edition of the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code. It must be completed for all permit applications for existing buildings and structures. Such as building, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, fire protection, and sign permits. It is not required for new free standing buildings or structures.

Regardless of any determination herein, if asbestos has been or is found in areas affected by construction it is the owners' responsibility to comply with all Federal, Commonwealth of Virginia and local asbestos laws and regulations including any necessary permits from the Virginia Department of Labor and Industry, OSHA, VDOT and the City.

Street address of the building or structure to be altered, renovated, demolished or moved: Part 1 Was the building or structure constructed prior to January 1, 1985? No – STOP No asbestos inspection required. Yes, proceed to next question. Part 2 Does this permit involve: Work on a commercial building? Work on a residential building with five (5) or more dwelling units? Work on a residential building for commercial or public development purposes? If any of these options are checked, the building or structure must be inspected by a Virginia licensed asbestos inspector. Part 3 _____, understand that the building or structure must be inspected by a Virginia licensed asbestos inspector. If asbestos is found, work must be done by a Virginia licensed asbestos abatement contractor to remove the asbestos containing materials. I understand that, in certain circumstances, the building or structure may be assumed to contain asbestos and work will be performed by a Virginia licensed asbestos abatement contractor to remove the materials. The necessary reports shall be provided to the Building Inspection Division. Signature Date Property Owner/Legal Agent

Note: A Building Permit is required to perform as bestos abatement and removal work in the City of Harrisonburg.
