⁴ The Harrisonburg Planning Commission meets in City Council Chambers, 409 South Main Street, at 6pm. City Council meets in City Council Chambers at 7pm. Applicants are encouraged to verify meeting dates and times with staff.

⁵ At the prior month's Planning Commission meeting, Planning Commission will determine if all upcoming agenda items will be heard at the first regular meeting of the month, or a second regular meeting is needed.

⁶ Rezonings and zoning ordinance amendments require two readings at City Council. Except for street and alley closings, all other items are typically voted on and completed at the first City Council meeting.
