




The Harrisonburg-Rockingham Emergency Communications Center (HRECC) wants to help you keep your livestock and farmland safe.

In the event of an emergency involving livestock or farmland the HRECC is tasked with contacting property owners in order to expedite the process of ensuring the safety of your land and animals. In doing so, the HRECC maintains a database which serves as a repository of information regarding livestock locations in Rockingham County and includes the locations of livestock, type of livestock, owner information and owner contacts. This information is then utilized in the event of an emergency or situation involving your land or livestock, and is not provided to any person outside of public safety.

Without this vital information at the fingertips of the 9-1-1 Center, it can often take over an hour to make contact with property owners or victims of crimes or other emergency situations. Simply put, we use this information to better serve you!


