SPECIFICATIONS

TRAFFIC CONTROL DRUMS

GENERAL

The following specifications are for the furnishing of Traffic Construction area drums w/removable weighted bases on a monthly rental basis, for use by the City Public Works Department for traffic control throughout the City.

DESIGN

All units shall meet the requirements of the Virginia Work Area Protection Manual (Standards and Guidelines) revised 11/96 drums 6F-5-D.

LOCATION

All units to be furnished to and maintenance performed at the City Shop, located at 320 E. Mosby Road, or if 10 or more units are assigned to a specific location, those units will be serviced on the project site.

MAINTENANCE

The unit shall be serviced as needed. The vendor shall be responsible for furnishing all replacements. The units shall be maintained in a condition to meet all specifications. Units to be washed as needed, or replaced if damaged or deteriorated beyond repair.

REPLACEMENT

The vendor shall be responsible for maintaining the number of units specified by this contract, and to replace all units which are damaged, vandalized, or stolen at no additional cost to the City.
