

2021 Harrisonburg Holiday Parade

Rules and Regulations

Saturday, December 11, 2021

*** PLEASE BE AWARE THERE WILL BE NO JUDGING OF PARADE ENTRIES ***

1. Every entry should be lit and/or decorated. Please try to be creative and adhere to the parade theme "Winter Wonderfest".
2. **Open flames, snow blowers and snow machines are not permitted.**
3. Items may be handed from your entry to pedestrians walking through the reverse parade.
4. Groups are permitted a maximum of 1 vehicle (plus float if appropriate) per entry. Max 40 feet
5. Floats must have a fire extinguisher on them or in the vehicle pulling them.
6. No part of a float or any entry should exceed 14 feet vertical from street level. All entries must be able to move under public utility wires. Any entry utilizing a motor vehicle must have working tail lights. No 18 wheelers are allowed.
7. No walking, animals, nor bicycle groups this year.
8. Drivers of all vehicles in the parade must have a valid Virginia driver's license.
9. Parade staging will be from 5:30-6pm in your designated spot. Spots will be assigned after maximum number of float entries are reached. Pedestrians will be walking through between 6-8pm. ***You must remain in your location until given the "all clear" from the Harrisonburg Police Department.***
10. Please provide a complete description of your entry and each entry must display the name of the group and organization. Trucks must remain hooked to all floats/trailers.
11. All float entries must be safe for passengers and spectators. Seats on floats must be firmly attached or passengers should have holding bars.
