*Prior to 2020, HPD utilized a records management system that required incidents have an "offense" associated with a report in the RMS, even if the report was not criminal in nature. HPD used "90Z All other Offense" for these instances.

While a large number of incidents are reported to the police, many are not crime related. Mental health incidents, natural death investigations, and others were entered into the past RMS as a 90Z All Other offense.

In late 2019, HPD replaced the records management system. Non-criminal incidents can now be reported without assigning an "offense" to the report. This explains the large drop in 90Z offenses in 2020.
