HPD Credit Card Fraud Case Linked to Other Incidents

The Harrisonburg Police Department continues to investigate a larceny and credit card fraud that occurred several months ago.

On January 16, a woman reported that her wallet had been taken while she was shopping at Goodwill, 1740 E. Market St.

Approximately 20 minutes after the victim's property was taken, her credit card was fraudulently used at Target, 1995 E. Market St. Charges were later placed on the victim's credit card from Walmart in Winchester, VA.

More than \$2,600 was fraudulently charged on the victim's credit cards.

As the investigation progressed, it was determined the individuals involved in this incident have also been responsible for several other similar cases in neighboring jurisdictions.

HPD is asking anyone with information on the suspects pictured in the surveillance images, to call Crime Solvers at 540-574-5050. Crime Solvers is an anonymous tip line and callers could receive up to a \$1,000 reward.
