Investigation Continues into Weekend Shooting

Dec. 12, 2011

Investigators with the Harrisonburg Police Department continue collecting information and working to determine a motive for the weekend shooting.

Around 2 a.m. on Sunday, Dec. 11, officers responded to the 1400 block of Bradley Drive for the report of a person shot.

As a group of males were exiting a vehicle, the offender opened the sliding door of a minivan and shot one male in the upper leg. The offender was sitting inside the minivan at the time of the shooting.

The 19-year-old victim was taken to Rockingham Memorial Hospital with non-life threatening injuries and has since been released.

The offender is described as a black male and was last seen in a gray or silver minivan. The minivan was occupied with several other individuals.

Police also ask local businesses in the area to check their surveillance cameras from the weekend to assist in identifying and locating the minivan and its occupants.
