HPD Reminds Motorists to Buckle Up

The Harrisonburg Police Department, along with many other law enforcement agencies, will soon begin the annual Click It or Ticket campaign.

Beginning May 21 and running until June 3, motorists can expect to see additional officers patrolling as part of Click It or Ticket Virginia. Their focus will be on safety belts and ensuring child safety seats are properly installed.

“We encourage motorists and passengers to buckle up year-round,” said Mary-Hope Vass, HPD’s Public Information Officer. “The Click It or Ticket campaign provides law enforcement more resources to educate the community on the importance of safety belts and enforce those in violation.”

Officers with HPD will be conducting saturation patrols and checkpoints throughout the campaign.

Police encourage all occupants of a motor vehicle, not only the driver, to wear safety belts.

This is also a reminder to make sure your vehicle is current on the registration, city, county, or town stickers, and the inspection.
