**HPD Continues to Investigate Credit Card Larceny/Fraud**

(Update to previous release)

**August 27, 2014**

On July 27, officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department received a report of a credit card larceny and credit card fraud that occurred in the 100 Block of Burgess Road. The victim in the case reported that her credit card was stolen and then used to purchase items at multiple locations in and around the Harrisonburg Crossing shopping area.

Video surveillance was initially obtained and photographs were released regarding this incident on August 9, 2014.

**8/27/2014 UPDATE:** Upon further investigation, HPD has obtained additional information regarding this incident and is requesting assistance from the public in identifying a person of interest. HPD has learned that a person involved in this incident may be known by the nickname of "Face", and attached to this release is an additional photograph of this individual.

HPD is encouraging anyone in the community who may know the identity of the person in the photo or have additional information on this case to contact the Harrisonburg Police Department Criminal Investigations Division at 540-437-2640.
