HPD Searching for Identity of Credit Card Larceny/Fraud Suspect

September 24, 2014

On September 15, officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department received a report of a credit card larceny and fraud. The victim reported his wallet, along with several credit/debit cards, were stolen from his vehicle in the early morning hours of the 15th. Later that day, the victim's credit cards were fraudulently used at the Royal Gas station on Port Road, the Walmart on Burgess Road and the Bar-B-Q Ranch on North Valley Pike.

Video surveillance has been obtained of the suspect at the time of one of the fraudulent purchases. Please see attached photos.

The suspect of the fraud is described as a white male, medium build, and having a mustache. He was identified as wearing khaki shorts, a black in color hooded sweatshirt, dark colored shoes, and a black in color toboggan or beanie with a white emblem. The suspect was also wearing sunglasses at the time of the offense.
