Subjects wanted in Harrisonburg City larcenies apprehended in West Virginia.

These charges stemmed from incidents that occurred yesterday afternoon in the City of Harrisonburg at the Roses on North Mason Street, and the Campus Corner on Port Republic Rd. In each of these incidents, money was taken out of the cash registers of both businesses. The suspects in both incidents were driving a vehicle that was previously reported stolen from New York earlier in the morning. After the incidents in the City, the vehicle was found wrecked in the 10,000 block of Rawley Pike.

Later that evening at approximately 7:00PM, Raymond Hottois, 46, Loren Hottois, 50, and Robert Blake, 50, from Monroe County, New York were apprehended by the West Virginia State Police, the Pendleton County Sheriff's Office, and the U.S. Forest Service in Brandywine, West Virginia.

All three men are currently being held in West Virginia, without bond, on two counts of conspiracy to steal property from a person, two counts of stealing property from a person, one count each of conspiracy to buy and receive stolen goods, and one count each of buying or receiving stolen goods or property.

The investigation is still ongoing, and both Raymond and Loren Hottois are also wanted out of New York State on unrelated outstanding probation violations.
