HPD Warns Citizens of Motor Vehicle Break-Ins

Harrisonburg, VA –

In the past few days, the Harrisonburg Police Department has taken a number of reports from citizens regarding thefts from motor vehicles. The majority of these incidents have occurred in specific areas of the city, to include off Campus College housing, Rocco Drive, Pleasant Hill Road, and surrounding streets. During these incidents, suspects gained entry to the vehicles through open windows and unlocked doors. These incidents are also believed to have occurred in the night time, or early morning hours, while residents were in their homes.

Harrisonburg Police are encouraging citizens to lock their vehicles and ensure valuables are not left in plain view. As always, be aware of your surroundings, and call police if you see something suspicious in your neighborhood.
