HPD Launches Neighborhood Eyes Program

Harrisonburg, VA – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) is proud to announce the official launching of their new program “Neighborhood Eyes.”

The Harrisonburg Police Department encourages all citizens and business, privately and publically owned, to register their surveillance systems. This can be done by visiting going online at <http://www.harrisonburgva.gov/neighborhood-eyes-registration> and filling out the online registration form.

Additionally, HPD reminds those registering their surveillance systems that this program **does not** give law enforcement remote access to your camera system and you will not be asked to provide any log on or password information. Neighborhood Eyes is a voluntary program and while citizens and businesses are strongly encouraged to register their camera as a site with a functioning system, it is not required.

This program gives HPD knowledge to where cameras are located for when crimes occur. Neighborhood Eyes will assist officers and investigators in cases where video evidence may be helpful in solving a crime.
