On Sunday, December 27, 2015, officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department responded to five incidents in the City of Harrisonburg where different businesses received counterfeit \$100 bills. These bills were passed at various convenience stores between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Each of the counterfeit bills had the same serial number and in each instance a female suspect used a counterfeit bill to make a purchase. Further investigation revealed that there were three black females (pictured below) who apparently worked in conjunction to pass these bills, and each was described as being between 25 and 35 years-old. It is believed that these suspects were driving a silver, older model Ford sedan, possibly a Taurus, with out of state license plates.

HPD is asking the public to assist in identifying these individuals. Anyone with additional information is asked to call the Criminal Investigations Division at (540) 437-2640.
