HPD Makes Arrest in Vehicle Break-Ins

Harrisonburg, VA – On August 8, 2016 officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department responded to Cracker Barrel at 121 Pleasant Valley Road for a report of a larceny from a vehicle. The victim described multiple items to the officers that were stolen from his locked vehicle while he was inside the restaurant. Further investigation led officers to a nearby motel where a vehicle matching the suspect's was seen leaving the parking lot by a male also matching the suspect's description. A traffic stop was initiated and contact was made with a male driver and female passenger later identified as Todd Derrecus Howard, 30, and Kimiko Ligan Prysock, 28, both of Atlanta, Georgia.

During the course of the investigation, some of the victim's stolen property was located within the vehicle being driven by Howard and Prysock. Among these items were other miscellaneous electronics found to be stolen from other locations in Harrisonburg. Subsequent to the traffic stop, both subjects were taken into custody and charged with the following:

Todd Derrecus Howard was charged with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, three counts of grand larceny, three counts of conspiracy to commit larceny, one count of possession of burglarious tools, three counts of vehicle tampering, one count of possession of marijuana, and one count of providing false identity to law enforcement.

Kimiko Ligan Prysock was charged with three counts of grand larceny, three counts of conspiracy to commit larceny, one count of possession of burglarious tools, three counts of vehicle tampering, and one count of possession of marijuana.

Both subjects are currently being held at the Rockingham County Jail without bond.
