Upcoming HPD Police Officer Testing

Harrisonburg, VA – The Harrisonburg Police Department would like to remind the community about the next set of testing for the open position of Police Officer with several positions open. Testing will be on October 15, 2016 with the deadline to register of October 6, 2016 at 5pm. Information is available to those interested on the Harrisonburg City website under Employment.

A hiring process will immediately open in which we will review applications and offer interviews. Those who pass the interviews will be offered a polygraph examination, followed by a background investigation, physical and psychological exams, and a final interview with the chief of police. The Harrisonburg Police Department is making an effort to resemble in diversity the community it serves. Attractive candidates would possess a college degree and/or military experience as well as being bilingual.

We are also accepting applications from Virginia certified officers looking to transfer from another agency. We offer an increased salary over non-certified applicants. Certified officers are exempt from written testing but must successfully complete the physical agility test before being offered an interview.
