HPD Investigates Traffic Crash Involving Bicyclist

Harrisonburg, VA – On Tuesday, October 18 at approximately 9:19 a.m. officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) responded to a traffic crash on West Grace Street, near the intersection of Walnut Lane.

The preliminary investigation has shown that a 19-year-old male was driving a 2011 Honda sedan eastbound on West Grace Street. He was attempting to make a left turn onto Walnut Lane, when he struck a 21-year-old female, who was traveling westbound on her bicycle at the time of the accident.

The Harrisonburg Police Department was assisted at the scene by the Harrisonburg Fire Department and the Harrisonburg Rescue Squad.

The female victim was transported by the Harrisonburg Rescue Squad to Sentara Rockingham Memorial Hospital with non-life threatening injuries and has since been released.

The crash remains under investigation by HPD's Accident Reconstruction Team.
