HPD Seeks Assistance Identifying Suspects in Recent Vandalism Cases

Harrisonburg, VA – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) is seeking assistance from the public with identifying three suspects in multiple recent vandalism cases. These vandalisms, specifically graffiti, began occurring in late August and have continued through the end of October.

Majority of these incidents have occurred in and around downtown Harrisonburg at locations including R.S. Monger and Sons, Howard A. Spangler Company, Ten Thousand Villages, and the Massanutten Regional Library.

The three suspects (pictured below) believed to be responsible for these crimes are described as two females and one male. One suspect is described as a white female approximately 5'6 and weighing around 120 pounds with long dark hair. She was seen on surveillance video wearing a brown sweater with dark shorts that had white markings. She was also wearing a small black cross body purse.

The second female is described as a white female approximately 5'4 and weighing around 125 pounds with blonde hair, pulled back. She was last seen wearing a yellow tank top with dark colored shorts and an olive colored back pack.

The third suspect is described as a white male approximately 5'11 and weighing around 170 pounds. He was seen on video wearing a white t-shirt, black pants, white Adidas tennis shoes, and a green hat. He also appears to have some facial hair and was wearing a watch on his left wrist at the time of the offense.
