## HPD Investigates Traffic Crash Involving Pedestrian

Harrisonburg, VA – On November 12, 2016 at approximately 6:30 a.m. officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) responded to the 800 Block of Martin Luther King Way for a traffic crash involving a pedestrian. An adult male, 58, of Harrisonburg was transported by the Harrisonburg Rescue Squad to Sentara RHM with life-threatening injuries.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the male was struck by a light blue, Honda (unknown model) in the early morning hours on Saturday. This vehicle fled the scene after striking the male and may have damage to the driver's side front bumper and door area.

The northbound lanes of the 800 Block of Martin Luther King Way were closed for approximately two hours.

The investigation is still on-going and more information will be released when available.
