## HPD Investigating Armed Robbery

Harrisonburg, VA – On November 17 at approximately 1:15 a.m., officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) responded to a report of an armed robbery in the 200 block of Kelley Street.

Officers arrived on scene within minutes and were able to obtain descriptions of three suspects that displayed firearms while demanding personal belongings from the victim. During the incident, one suspect spoke in Arabic to the victim.

They are described as all being male suspects, two taller males between 5 feet 10 inches and 6 foot, and one shorter male between 5 feet 5 inches and 5 feet 7 inches. Surveillance video from the area shows three subjects in this area at the time of the offense matching this description (pictured below).

The shorter subject is wearing a dark colored leather jacket and dark pants. The second suspect is wearing dark tan or grey pants with a navy colored sweatshirt and black Adidas shoes. The third suspect is wearing khaki pants and a black jacket with a black scarf around his face. All three subjects have hats on or hoods up and may have had their faces covered at the time of the offense.

The suspects fled the scene toward Washington Street and were later seen running from this area back toward Kelley Street near Lincoln Circle.
