HPD Requesting Assistance Locating Missing Child

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) is seeking assistance from the public in locating a missing child.

Jace Alexander Coffey, 4, of Harrisonburg, was last seen on January 15 in Harrisonburg with his mother, Kimberly Ann Campbell, 23, of Stanley, Va.

On January 15, Jace’s mother picked him up from his residence in Harrisonburg to take him home for the night in Stanley. They were last seen yesterday at approximately 2:00 p.m., but never arrived at their destination in Stanley.

Since leaving Harrisonburg, Kimberly was believed to have traveled to Luray where she and Jace possibly stopped at Walmart.


The two were last seen traveling in a 2007 silver Toyota Yaris bearing VA registration VRD-8554. Jace was last seen wearing a blue and grey shirt with blue jeans and spider man shoes that light up. He stands at approximately 3 feet 2 inches and weighs approximately 38 pounds with brown hair and brown eyes.

Kimberly was last seen wearing a jean jacket with colorful sleeves. She has short black curly hair that is usually up in a handkerchief. She also has a nose piercing and a tattoo on her right wrist.

While the exact circumstances surrounding this incident are unknown, foul play is not suspected at this time.
