## HPD Investigates Weapon Law Violation

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) continues investigating a reported weapon law violation that took place this week.

In the evening hours of February 13, officers responded to the report of an attempted aggravated assault in the area of Morrison Park, which is located at the intersection of Chicago Avenue and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

Patrol officers interviewed the alleged victims from the incident and detectives from the Major Crimes Unit responded to the scene of the offense and conducted an investigation.

Preliminary information is that, a dark colored vehicle with four occupants drove past the victims and discharged a weapon at an occupied vehicle.

No one was injured during the altercation, but a vehicle did sustain minor damage. This incident appears to be isolated and the victims and offenders were known to each other.
