### **Harrisonburg Police Seek Assistance in Credit Card Fraud**

Harrisonburg – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) is asking for help from the community in identifying and locating a suspect involved responsible for credit card fraud.

On the night of May 13, HPD received a report of a credit card fraud that had occurred earlier in the evening at Dick’s Sporting Goods, which is located at 1925 E. Market Street.

During the course of the investigation, an officer with HPD was able to review the surveillance footage at Dick’s Sporting Goods and noted three subjects, a male and two females, purchasing items with the stolen credit card number.

The subjects are described as possibly being Hispanic. The male had short black hair and was wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt or sweater. One of the females had blonde or light brown hair and was wearing a sleeveless dark top. The other female had long dark hair in a pony tail and was wearing a light colored shirt. The subjects then exited the store together and walked towards JC Penney.
