HPD Arrests Two as a Result of Vehicle Pursuit

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) arrested two individuals in connection with a pursuit that started in Harrisonburg and ended in Rockingham County Tuesday afternoon. HPD officers were assisted by the Rockingham County Sheriff's Office and the Virginia State Police.

Debra Sue Campbell, 46, of Waynesboro, was charged by HPD for felony eluding, driving revoked, DUID, possession of marijuana, possession of a controlled substance, possess an imitation controlled substance, and possession of a firearm having been convicted of a felony.

Sabrina Paige Fulton, 27, of Harrisonburg, was charged by HPD with possession of a controlled substance, and possession of controlled paraphernalia.

Around 1:00 pm, an HPD patrol officer was attempting to make a traffic stop on a dark colored 4-door sedan on Port Republic Rd. near Forest Hills. The driver of the sedan failed to stop and attempted to elude the HPD unit, and a pursuit ensued, leading HPD officers, R.C.S.O. deputies, and the VSP through portions of the city, Interstate 81, into the county along Rt. 42 and Rt. 33, ending in Monte Vista Estates subdivision in the county. The suspects were arrested at the scene without further incident.

No injuries were reported.

Additional charges will be obtained by both the Rockingham County Sheriff's Office and the Virginia State Police.
