AMBER Alert Canceled but Search Continues

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD), along with its partnering agencies, continue investigating the disappearance of two females from the city.

Elizabeth Rodriguez Rubio, 48, and her granddaughter, Angie Carolina Rodriguez Rubio, 12, were reported missing the morning of Tuesday, August 7. On Tuesday, August 7, an AMBER Alert was initiated for the child who is 12-years-old and believed to be in extreme danger. Her grandmother, Elizabeth, was also entered into a nationwide system as a missing person.

The VSP has reported that this afternoon, the AMBER Alert for the missing Harrisonburg woman and child has been canceled. However, the search for them continues. In accordance with the program policy the Alert must be canceled after a period of time.

HPD and its partner agencies continue following up on all leads and the information received through the detectives' work with locating Elizabeth and Angie their top priority.

HPD remains the lead investigating agency, but is partnering with other local, state, and federal agencies to pursue information that is received in our area and surrounding jurisdictions.
