HPD Asks for Help from the Public

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD), continues working with partner agencies to locate two females who have not been seen since Sunday, August 5.

Members of the public are asked to come forward with additional information and to help investigators piece together information leading up to their disappearance.

Based on information received throughout the investigation, it is believed the suspect's vehicle (2001 red two-door Honda Civic) was on Interstate 81, between mile markers 251 and 256. The vehicle may have been stopped on the shoulder of the road in this area on Sunday, August 5 between the times of 3:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Elizabeth Rodriguez Rubio, 48, and her granddaughter, Angie Carolina Rodriguez Rubio, 12, were reported missing the morning of Tuesday, August 7. They were last seen in Harrisonburg on Sunday, August 5, early in the afternoon.

The suspect, Hareton Jamie Rodriguez Sariol, remains in law enforcement custody in Pennsylvania until his extradition to Virginia.

Property owners are encouraged to check their property for any evidence of human or vehicle activity that could aid in the investigation.

HPD remains the lead investigating agency, but is partnering with other local, state, and federal agencies to pursue information that is received in our area and surrounding jurisdictions.

Finding Elizabeth and Angie Rodriguez Rubio is HPD's top priority. **Anyone with immediate information as to their whereabouts is asked to call 911 immediately.
