Abduction Investigation Continues

Harrisonburg, Va. - The Harrisonburg Police Department continues to investigate an attempted abduction that occurred October 16 at approx. 11 a.m. at the Family Dollar, 700 block of East Market Street. According to witnesses, a white male, approximately 6'00" tall with brown hair and a beard, grabbed the female victim and attempted to take her from the property. The female escaped with minor injuries.

Later in the day, a person of interest in the case, Anthony E. Jabour, 24, from Massachusetts, was taken into custody for an assessment because he was a person in need of services. Mr. Jabour has now been excluded as being involved in the case and continues to be medically evaluated.
