HPD Requesting Assistance in Cloned Card Case

Harrisonburg, Va. – The Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD), is requesting assistance from the public in identifying a suspect involved in a credit card fraud that occurred at Kroger in Harrisonburg on October 6, 2018.

The victim reported that the card was still in their possession, so it is likely that the card was recently used where a card skimmer was attached to the reader. The location where the information was compromised is still unknown. The suspect also had the victim's PIN number and was able to successfully use the card at an ATM to withdraw funds.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male in his 40's or early 50's. At the time of the offense he was wearing a black t-shirt, green shorts, and tan shoes, with a very short hair cut. Furthermore, he appears to be around 6 feet tall and about 220 pounds.
