HPD Investigating Early Morning Shooting

HARRISONBURG, Va.: Officers with the Harrisonburg Police Department (HPD) responded to the 100 block of North Main Street on Sunday, March 31, at approximately 02:00 a.m. for a complaint of a victim with a gunshot wound. The Emergency Communication Center (ECC) received reports of shots fired from the 200 block of North Main Street around this time.

HPD Officers responded and quickly located the victim on the sidewalk near West Wolfe Street. Officers provided immediate medical care until the Harrisonburg Rescue Squad arrived. The victim, a 19-year-old female from Rockingham County, was transported to Sentara RMH Medical Center for her non-life-threatening injuries.

HPD is currently seeking input from anyone with information about this incident or the identity of the suspect(s). A suspect(s) description is unavailable as HPD's Major Crimes Unit investigates leads on their identity. This appears to be an isolated incident, and it is not believed there is any risk to the public at this time.
