**a. Safe Routes to School Spotswood Elementary School**

Right-of-way acquisition continues. Plans are being finalized. Construction is expected in summer 2018.

**b. Garbers Church Road Shared Use Path**

A presentation and public hearing are planned for the January 23rd City Council meeting. Staff will request right-of-way authorization from City Council, after which staff can begin negotiating right-of-way with property owners for the project. Construction is still anticipated in 2019. Public Works will find out in the Spring whether the grant request for additional funds to go toward the construction of Phase II (Hillandale Park to Thomas Harrison Middle School) was successful.

**c. North End Greenway**

Staff recently provided comments to the engineers on the 60% plans. A presentation and public hearing will be held with City Council this Winter or early Spring. Right-of-way acquisition will take place over the winter. It is expected to be under construction in the summer, and completed in the fall.

**d. School zone analysis (On Hold)**

An inventory of traffic controls in school zones is complete. Next steps include an analysis and discussions within Public Works and with Harrisonburg Police Department and Safe Routes to School partners.
