a. Safe Routes to School Spotswood Elementary School

Right-of-way acquisition is nearly complete. Construction is expected in summer/fall of 2018.

b. Garbers Church Road Shared Use Path

To be discuss at the meeting. A general overview of the status can be found in the recording of the April 24, 2018 City Council meeting, as well as local media.

c. North End Greenway, Phase I

A presentation and public hearing will be held with City Council in June to show the construction plans and to authorize a comprehensive agreement with the design/build team to allow the construction of the path. Right-of-way acquisition is underway. The path is expected to be under construction in the summer, and completed in the fall.
