a. Safe Routes to School Spotswood Elementary School

The City was not able to obtain contractor bids within the budget of the project and is now going through a process to allow the project to be constructed using City forces. It is pending approval from VDOT. Construction is expected in the Summer of 2019.

b. Garbers Church Road Shared Use Path (no change)

VHB (engineering consultant) is now redesigning the path between Hillandale Park and Garbers Church Road. The new alignment is along the border of the golf course on city property, and onto the Bluestone Elementary School property. The new schedule is planned as follows:

- 60% plans – January 2019 (present)
- Right of way acquisition – winter 2019 – winter 2020
- 100% plans – July 2019
- Bid project – winter 2019/2020
- Construction – Summer 2020

c. North End Greenway, Phases I & II

Construction of Phase I is underway.

An agreement has been executed between the City and the New Community Project to construct Phase II (Jefferson Street to Monroe Street). Construction is expected to begin over the winter and be completed by Spring.
