• Garbers Church Road Shared Use Path

The schedule is planned as follows:

- 60% plans Completed in early 2019
- 100% plans Completed
- Right of way acquisition Underway
- Bid project Fall/Winter 2020
- Construction 2021

• Northend Greenway, Phases I & II

Phase I: Construction complete!

Phase II: Community effort complete and paving completed!

• Federal Street Shared Use Path – Elizabeth Street to E. Market Street

Construction expected to be completed in May or June 2020

Audible Pedestrian Signal implementation

Audible pedestrian signals communicate "walk" and "don't walk" information to pedestrians, which is essential for the mobility and safety of visually-impaired residents. This project, funded by VDOT through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), will make upgrades to add audible pedestrian signals at many intersections in the City. All intersection improvements have been identified.

Initial schedule:

- Bid Fall 2020
- Construction Winter 2020/2021

Mt. Clinton Pike (no change)

The scope of this project includes addition of a shared use path (extension of the Northend Greenway) on the north side of Mt. Clinton Pike between Park Rd and Virginia Ave and road design modifications, likely including addition of a turn lane at Mt. Clinton Pike and Chicago Ave. Filling sidewalk gaps on the south side of Mt. Clinton Pike is also planned, unless the cost of other aspects uses all of the available funding.

Initial schedule:

- 60% Plans Winter 2021
- Public Involvement Winter 2021
- Right of Way/Utilities 2021
- Bid Winter 2022
- Construction 2022
