

SUPPORT HARRISONBURG'S POLLUTED RUNOFF ACTION PLAN!

The City of Harrisonburg's storm sewer system is completely separate from the sanitary sewer system. Sanitary sewage flows through pipes into the Harrisonburg-Rockingham Regional Sewer Authority's wastewater treatment plant. Stormwater, including polluted runoff that contains oil, sediment, wastewater, etc. drains untreated directly into local surface waters like Blacks Run.

We all contribute to the pollutants that enter our local waterways. Harrisonburg is asking that everyone who contributes to polluted runoff be part of the solution. The City is proposing a local stormwater utility fee that will be invested locally on projects to filter, control, and treat polluted runoff before it reaches our waterways.
