What Water Quality Projects Have Been Identified?



The full list of projects identified by the Stormwater Improvement Plan includes over 100 new BMPs, 11 stream restorations, and 20 BMP retrofits. All projects were evaluated using the Prioritization and Ranking Criteria. Below, the top 11 projects of each BMP type are shown. BMP types include: new BMPs, which are new construction of structural BMPs; stream restorations, which rehabilitate degraded stream channels

using natural channel designs; and BMP retrofits, which are redesigns to existing BMPs that are

already constructed.

The projects recommended for implementation are those that are most effective in meeting pollutant removal requirements for the City. Top ranked projects will have an associated high priority concept plan meant for efficient grant submittals and capital improvement planning.
