Additionally, the following questions and answers have been provided:

1. Q: Will temporary stripping be required for traffic control during the daytime hours?

A: Yes

2. Q: If so will the city be responsible for it?

A: Yes

3. Q: In response to a question it was said that subcontractors needed to be prequalified with VDOT in accordance with section 105.06 of the VDOT Road and Bridge Specifications. In that section, the last paragraph states that this restriction does not apply to contract specialty item. I believe the 4" Cold In-Place Pavement Reclamation would qualify as a specialty item in this contract, do you agree?

A: The ITB did not specify the CIR as a specialty item, therefore all prequalification information is required for all subcontractors as stated in the ITB.

4. Q: Addenda Item 5 does not have the manhole adjustment on the bid form. If we were to use the bottom portion of the original bid form it does not have a space for unit price and extended amount.

A: Please use the revised bid form included with this addenda.

All other requirements, terms and conditions of the ITB remain unchanged.
