Section of Keezletown Road to temporary close for repairs

HARRISONBURG, Va. – Harrisonburg Public Works will temporary close a section of Keezletown Road on Thursday, July 10, weather-permitting, to effect unscheduled repairs to a storm culvert.

Keezletown Road will be closed between Country Club Road and Smithland Road for the majority of the day Thursday to allow repairs to take place. Drivers should use Smithland Road and Linda Lane as a detour. Signage will be in place to inform motorists.

Any delays in reopening Keezletown Road will be posted to the City's social media pages.
