On Saturday, May 9, 2026, the Harrisonburg Parks & Recreation Department will present its annual Spring Dance Concerts. The concerts will be held at Harrisonburg High School at 1:00 and 7:00 p.m. Dress rehearsals will be Wednesday May 6 (for the earlier concert) and Thursday May 7 (for the later concert). Both rehearsals will begin at 5:30 p.m. at Harrisonburg High School.

Classes with the title of: Advanced Youth Ballet, Advanced Ballet & Beginning Pointe, Advanced Youth Jazz, Modern/Lyrical, Upper-Level Advanced Ballet & Pointe, Advanced Jazz, Advanced Modern/Lyrical, Teen/Preteen Tap & Musical Stage, and Blue Crew will participate in both dress rehearsals on Wednesday, May 6 and Thursday, May 7 at 5:30 pm and both dance concerts on Saturday, May 9 at 1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Classes with the title of: Music and Movement and Pre-Ballet/Creative Movement will participate in the dress rehearsal on Wednesday, May 6 at 5:30 p.m. and the dance concert on Saturday, May 9 at 1:00 p.m.

Classes with the title of: Ballet/Tap, Beg. /Int. Jazz, Int./Adv. Ballet, and Int./Adv. Jazz, will participate in the dress rehearsal on Thursday May 7 at 5:30 p.m. and the dance concert on Saturday, May 9 at 7:00 p.m.

All classes are scheduled to participate. Please sign and return this sheet so that your child may participate. The semester will be devoted to the concert, and we strongly urge that each child participate in the concert and regularly attend class. A costume must be ordered for each dancer for each class. The costume will be selected by the instructor and will cost between \$35 and \$80 depending on the size and style. Every effort will be made to select the least expensive costume while assuring the costume aligns with the choreography, music, and size. Costumes are not custom made and may be made smaller or larger in size depending on the costume companies' available stock. Parents may be asked to adjust their child's costume. Call times, costume necessities, and other concert information will be distributed at a later date. By signing either section below, students and guardians agree to abide by all policies and behavior clauses set forth by the dance program and Parks and Recreation.
