



Westover Pool Rules

1. All guests are expected to always obey the Lifeguards and Managers.
2. The management of Westover Pool reserves the right to refuse admittance to or to suspend/terminate privileges of any guest/s failing to comply with any rules. All City of Harrisonburg policies are abided by in this facility.
3. Westover Pool is a Drug/Alcohol/and Tobacco Free area. Any guest using tobacco products must do so only in the main parking lot area.
4. Additional rules are posted at the climbing wall, splash pad, and diving area.
5. Parents/Guardians are expected to always supervise their children while at Westover Pool & Splashpad
6. Parents/Guardians are expected to be always within arm's reach of any young guest in a floatation device.
7. All guests are asked to shower prior to entering the water. People with infectious diseases, communicable diseases or open sores are prohibited from using Westover Pool and Splashpad.
8. All guests are expected to dress appropriately to either swim or supervisor swimmers. Guests wearing inappropriate attire will be asked to change to family friendly attire.
9. Diaper-dependent guests must wear an approved swim diaper before entering the water.
10. Lockers are available, and Westover Pool encourages their use. Guests must provide their personal lock and all locks are to be removed at the end of your visit. Westover Pool is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property.
11. Westover Pool may close during inclement weather. In addition, Westover Pool reserves the right to close early without notice if the following conditions are met: the temperature falls below 65F with less than 15 swimmers present.
12. All guests are expected to be responsible for their belongings and for the disposal of all trash. Guests are responsible for any damage occurring to Westover Pool during their visit.
13. The following activities are not permitted in Westover Pool running, profane and vulgar language, use of water guns, spitting, spouting, urinating, horseplay, pushing, shoving, wrestling, dunking, etc.
14. Please report any accident or injury to Westover Pool staff immediately.
15. No pets are allowed within Westover Pool grounds, service animals excluded.
16. Boom boxes and radios without headphones are not permitted inside the Westover Pool area. Personal music players with headphones are welcome anywhere in Westover Pool.
17. Pool toys (soft balls, noodles, kickboards, rafts, etc.) are only to be used in the Olympic Pool. Use of these items need to either all in the water or all out of the water. Respect those around you enjoying the facilities. If the guest load is high, the lifeguards may request that toys be removed.
18. Any guests may be asked to take a deep-water swimming test to use the diving boards. The test includes swimming the length of the pool and floating.
