

# NORTH MASON ST. CORRIDOR STUDY

## BACKGROUND:

This study is evaluating concepts that reconfigure North Mason Street, between E. Market Street and N. Main Street, to improve safety and reimagine this section of the roadway. This study is informed by the feedback and data from the Demonstration Project, as well as by the goals and desires expressed in the Northeast Neighborhood Small Area Plan.



## GOALS & PRINCIPLES:

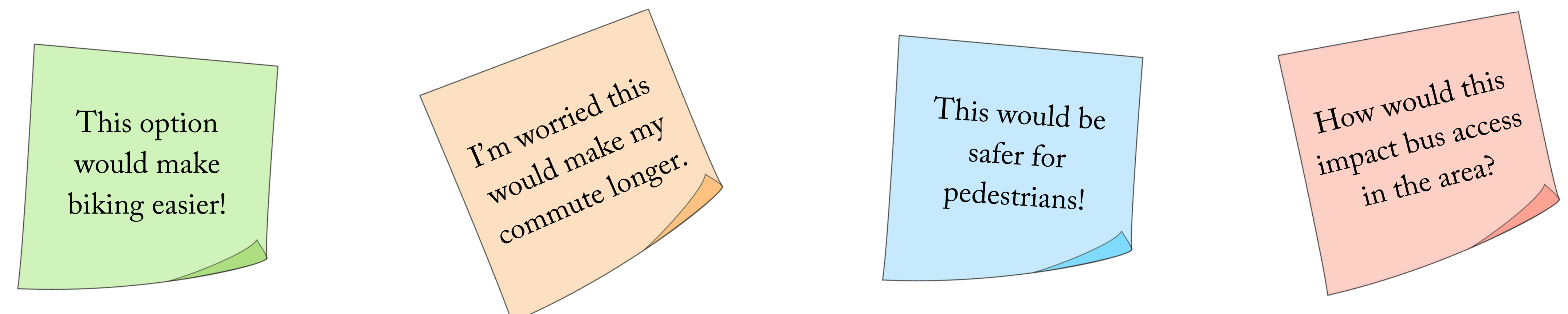
- Improve safety, particularly for people who are walking
- Reimagine North Mason Street by replacing some existing roadway space with new public space
- Ensure adequate capacity for traffic, supporting existing business and potential development
- Design with all modes of transportation in mind, including pedestrians, people biking, trucks (industrial and delivery), emergency vehicles and transit buses



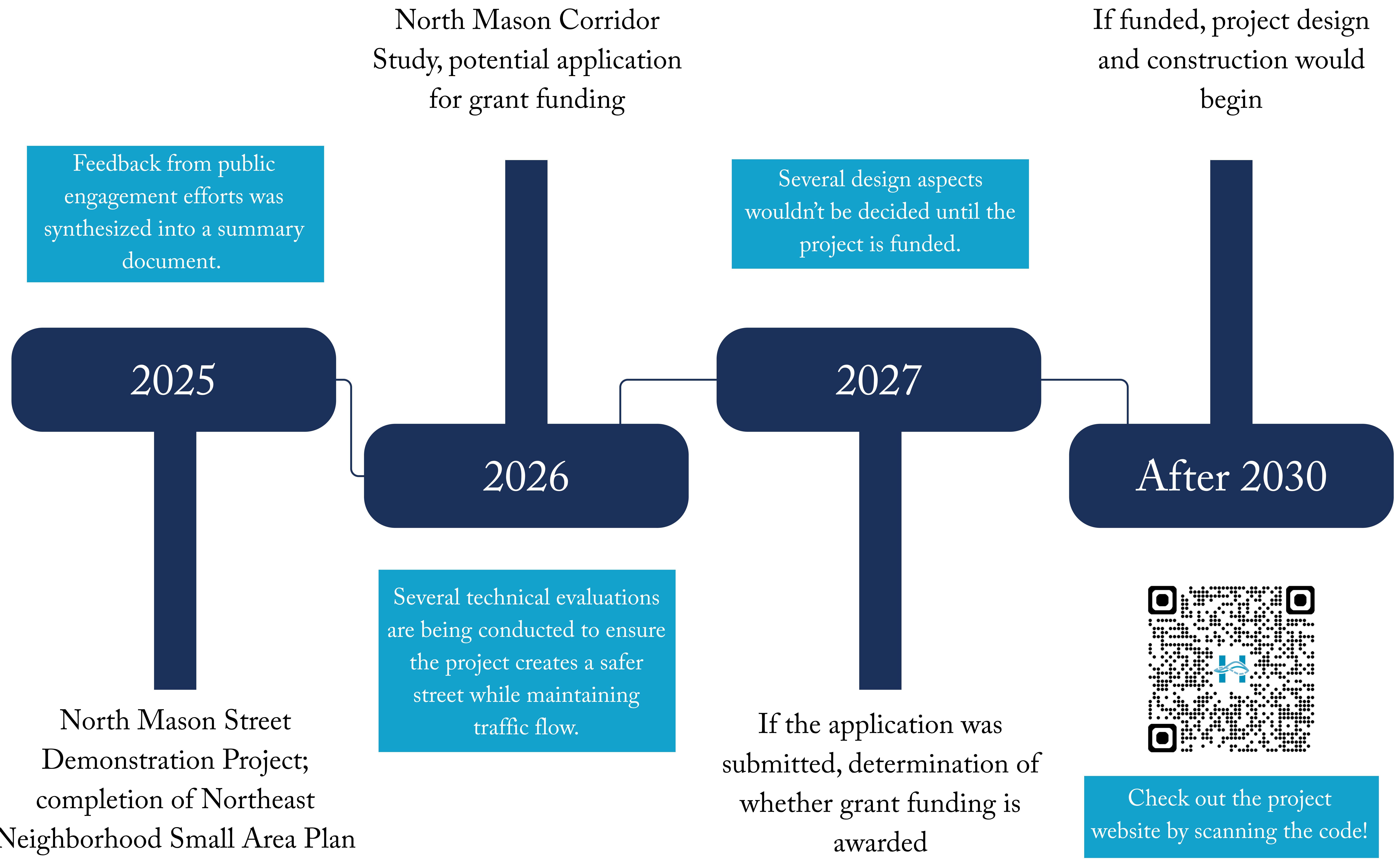
## HOW TO PARTICIPATE:
