Civil Disturbance/Unlawful Assembly

Call 540-434-4436 and ask to register your party. If a complaint comes in, a dispatcher will call the number registered and give a warning. If the violation is corrected, HPD will not be dispatched.

If more complaints are received, and the violation continues, officers will be dispatched. If the violation is sustained, a summons may be issued. If further violations are found, the party may be shut down and your landlord notified.

TAKE CARE. BE AWARE

- Travel with a group, especially at night
- Don't drink and drive & never get in a car with someone who has been drinking
- If you are 21, drink responsibly
- Don't allow strangers into your parties

- Call police immediately if you are the victim of a crime
